Attains a minimum grade point average of 2.7/4.0 (accumulative) Most recent report card can be used to verify grade point average.

Submit a letter of recommendation from your school instructor (Teacher or School Official), community leader or a member of the Inkster Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

Participate in an interview (Week of *Monday, May 16, 2022 starting at 5:00 pm, via Zoom*)

Is approved for membership by the Delta G.E.M.S. Advisory Board and Youth Group by simple majority vote.

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After membership has been granted, you MUST attend a minimum of three (3) G.E.M.S. activities/events during the year, outside of the regular monthly meetings, to be considered an active member.
